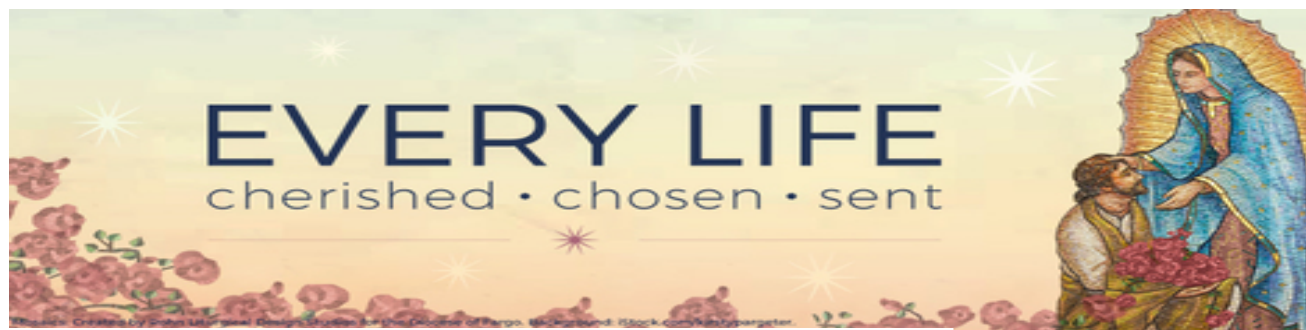

### Introducing Project Hope:

Project Hope seeks to provide a safe and confidential environment for those who struggle with mental health conditions to encounter Jesus Christ through community, support, and scripture. We will have the opportunity to share our own experiences and process our challenges through the lens of Scripture and Catholic teaching.
